11 COURSES

- “Introduction to Professional Writing”
- A modern British writers course such as “Major British Writers” or an American period course such as “From Revolution to Civil War”.
- A British literature course such as “Romance and War in Early England” or “Victorian Fallen Women and Self Made Men”
- An English genre course such as “Modern Poetry” or “19<sup>th</sup> Century Fiction”
- English authors course such as “Mark Twain” or “Chaucer”
- One writing in the workplace course; such as “Technical Writing” or “Business and Publications Writing”
- One creative genres course such as “Creative Writing-Poetry, “Prose; Creative Writing and Analyzing the Short Story”, “Creative Non-Fiction”, or “Writing Children’s Literature”
- One publishing course either “Writing or Editing for Publication” or “Word, Web and Design”
- One writing elective such as “Legal Writing” or “Writing in the Social Sciences”
