


## Remove the Lines in Access form headers and footers

You've just added a picture as a background to your form and now notice the line separating the header from the rest of the form. For a more attractive appearance, you would like a continuous background.

Follow these steps to remove the header line:

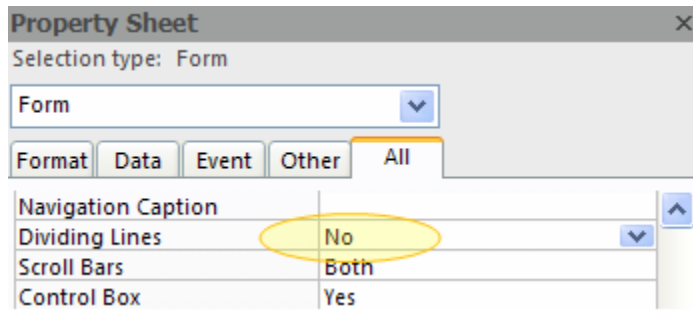

1. Open the Form in Design View.
2. Click on the All tab in the form's Property sheet.
3. Click in the Dividing Lines property text box.
4. Click the drop-down arrow and select No.
