

Delete a Line or Border in a PDF File





Situation:

After you create a PDF file from an Excel or Word document, you notice a line that shouldn't be there. Yet you want to leave the line in on the Excel or Word document.

Overview:

If there are extensive changes it is easier to edit the Excel or Word document but for a few lines you can do the job in Adobe Acrobat Professional 8 using the Advanced Editing toolbar.

Step by Step Instructions:

1.	Open the PDF file in Adobe Acrobat Professional 8
2.	Make sure the Advanced Editing toolbar is showing Menu: View, Toolbars, Advanced Editing 
3.	Advanced Editing toolbar 
4.	Click the last tool – Touch Up Object 
5.	Click the line in the PDF file. It will turn blue if it's selected 
6.	Press the Delete key The line is removed
