

How to Change the Dim on Exit for a Bulleted List

Situation:

A bulleted list appears point by point, which is what you want. But when you click to go to the next bullet point, the text you were looking at goes dim and is hard to read












Overview:

On the slide master, you will change the after animation effect of the bulleted list. Because the change was made on the slide master, all slides will be effected.

Step by Step Instructions:

<p>1. Display the Slide Master Click View tab Click Slide Master</p>	
<p>2. Select Animations tab Click Custom Animation</p>	
<p>3. The bulleted list slide master should be selected If it isn't, select the 3rd master from the list on the left</p>	

4.	Click the edge of the bulleted list box	
5.	In Custom Animation task pane Click list arrow next to Master: Body	
6.	You may have to select the bulleted list rectangle again You should see flags on the left side of the bulleted list	
7.	Right click the Rectangle effect Select Effect Options...	
8.	In the Appear dialog box Effect tab Enhancements – After animation Click Drop down list arrow	

9.	Select Don't Dim	
10.	Completed Appear Box Click OK	
11.	Click Slide Master tab	
12.	Close Slide master	
13.	Animated bulleted text doesn't dim, but stays the same color
