

Keyboard Shortcut to Move a Window – ALT + Spacebar

Normally two monitors are a joy to use, but if you remote desktop into your office computer that is so configured, you may not be able to see a program window even though it is open. That's because the window is on the other monitor that you can't see. If you can't see the window, you can't drag it to where you can see it.

This is a case for using a keyboard shortcut (ALT + Spacebar) to move the window

1.	Make sure the window really is active by looking at the taskbar.
2.	The button representing the program should look pushed in.
3.	Press: ALT + Spacebar
4.	You may see a 4 headed arrow at the edge of the screen
5.	Press: Left or Right arrow key to move the window into view
6.	You will see just the outline of the window
7.	Press: ENTER to drop the window in the spot indicated by the outline
