About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays made a late run, but lost to Widener 80-69 at Thompson Gymnasium on Saturday afternoon. Sophomore **G Keith Fogel** was the lone player to finish in double figures as he scored 10 points, while sophomore C **Chris Hill** came off the bench to post nine points and five rebounds. Sophomore **G Mark Vogel** also had a solid effort in a reserve role with seven points and three assists in 15 minutes of action... Elizabethtown matched its season high with 23 turnovers against Widener, but forced the Pride into 22 miscues. It was the 10th time in 16 games that a Blue Jay opponent committed 20 or more turnovers... The Blue Jays grabbed a season-high 19 offensive rebounds against Widener... Fogel has made 21 consecutive foul shots over the last 10 games, and continues to lead the conference in free-throw percentage at 91.7 percent (33-for-36)... Junior C **Mike Church** remains the conference leader in blocked shots at 1.56 per game... The Blue Jays have made between four and seven three pointers in each of their 16 games this season... Elizabethtown's turnover margin of +5.31 per game leads the conference, as does the Blue Jays' average of 11.75 steals per game... Elizabethtown is 4-2 in midweek games this season, and 4-6 on weekends.

About Lebanon Valley...

The Dutchmen claimed their first Commonwealth Conference win of the season with a 72-63 victory over Messiah on Saturday afternoon. Senior **G Kyle Enoch** led the Dutchmen with 16 points, leaving him just six points shy of reaching 1,000 for his career. In all, five players finished in double figures for Lebanon Valley, which went 27-for-35 from the foul line as a team compared to 10-for-12 by Messiah... Lebanon Valley lost its first three conference games by a total of eight points, including two-point losses to Lycoming and Albright. Entering the Messiah game, the Dutchmen had lost five out of six games following a four-game win streak just prior to Christmas... Enoch leads the Dutchmen in scoring, three-pointers (28) and steals (27) while ranking second on the team with 5.1 rebounds per game... First-year **G Joe Meehan** has scored in double figures in two of the last three games, including a season-high 13 points against Messiah and 12 points against Albright... Junior **F Dan Dunkelberger** has both of the Dutchmen's double-doubles this season, against Cabrini (22-12) and Albright (17-12)... Lebanon Valley has attempted at least 18 foul shots in every game this season, including a 37-for-43 performance against Cabrini and a 27-for-30 effort against FDU-Florham.
