About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays walloped Arcadia 76-41 on Saturday afternoon, with junior G **Courtney Kofeldt** hitting 4-for-4 from three-point range and scoring a team-high 14 points. Senior G **Megan Quinn** netted 12 points and matched her career highs with 14 rebounds and five assists, as Elizabethtown led by as many as 38 points... The 35-point margin of victory was a season high for the Blue Jays, while their +19 rebound difference matched a season best. Elizabethtown also finished with a season high in field-goal percentage at 48.4 percent (30-for-62)... Quinn's double-double was her seventh of the season and third in six conference games. She continues to lead the Commonwealth Conference in rebounds per game (8.9) and is third in scoring at 14.6 points per game... Senior G **Megan Romano** has moved into fourth place in the conference in free-throw percentage at 74.0 percent (37-for-50)... First-year G **Emily Mullen** scored the first 10 points of her career against Arcadia, going 4-for-6 from the field including 2-for-3 from three-point range in 11 minutes of action... Sophomore F **Kaity Snyder** made her season debut against Arcadia and scored six points in eight minutes... Elizabethtown head coach **Yonnie Kauffman** is one win shy of becoming the third NCAA Division III women's basketball coach to record 650 career victories.

About Immaculata...

The Mighty Macs lost at Baptist Bible 65-52 on Saturday afternoon. First-year F **Kelly Brown** led the way for Immaculata with 18 points while senior F **Dominique Murray** added 14 points and nine rebounds. The Mighty Macs shot 34 percent from the field as a team and committed 32 turnovers in the contest. The loss was the fifth in a row for Immaculata, which is 1-6 this month... Last Thursday, the Mighty Macs lost 70-51 at Cabrini as Brown led all players with 18 points... Brown leads the team in scoring at 12.8 points per game despite starting just six of the Mighty Macs' 15 games... Senior G **Kasey Hicks** ranks third in the Colonial States Athletic Conference with an average of 3.73 assists per game... First-year G **Bridget Welz** leads the team in three-pointers with 13 and in steals with 41. As a team, Immaculata has made just 33 three-pointers in 172 attempts (19.2 percent) and has been shut out from beyond the arc four times in 15 games... Last season, the Mighty Macs finished just 6-19 overall and 4-12 in what was known as the Pennsylvania Athletic Conference before it changed into the CSAC last summer... Immaculata is best known for winning three consecutive AIAW national championships from 1972-74 and appearing in five straight title games from 1972-76.
