1. Always allow pop ups from this site.
2. Click on Change to set the data retrieval period first.
Frequency—single or multiple (i.e. annual, quarterly, monthly)
Select start date of data
Select ending date of data
3. Select the Country via Country Tables
4. Put a check mark next to selected statistics (looking at the Print version of IFS is helpful
Ref 332.05 In61. We own from 2001 to present.)
5. Click on the + sign to add the data to your request
6. Click on Retrieve
7. Select an output option—CSV,XLS, HTM or tab delimited.
8. Choose save and put in a descriptive file name title and click on Retrieve Series. (It will be saved to the IFS server for about 5 days).
9. Before opening, the software asks if this is from a trusted source? Yes
10. I would recommend saving the file immediately to a private folder.
11. Students need a minimum of 30 data points to do a regression formula. Penn State Harrisburg has paper issues from v.22 (1969) to the present.
