

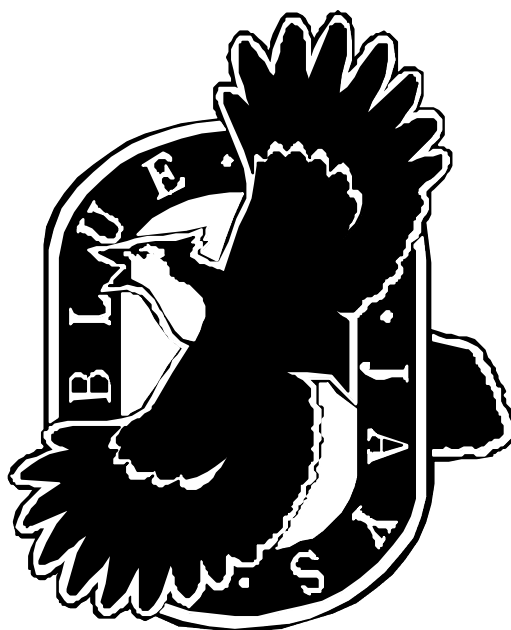

ABOUT ELIZABETHTOWN

Elizabethtown ran off with a 68-44 victory at Susquehanna in its Commonwealth Conference opener Tuesday night to snap a three game losing streak. The Blue Jays began the game by going on a 21-0 run in the opening nine minutes and retained a 37-16 lead at halftime. The Blue Jays held Susquehanna to just six-for-24 (25.0%) shooting from the field in the first half and 18-for-59 (30.5%) shooting from the field for the entire game. The Blue Jays shot 27-for-63 (42.9%) from the field. **Jessica Hollinshield** led Etown in scoring with 20 points and in steals with three. She also pulled down six rebounds and shot nine-for-14 from the field, including a four-for-five performance in the first half. **Megan Wolfe** scored 12 points and had four assists, and she shot four-for-five from three-point range. **Dana Voit** came off the Blue Jay bench to score 10 points and toss out four assists as well. Etown's top rebounders in the game were **Cristin Braun** and **Jen Roberts** with eight rebounds each. **Braun** also led the Blue Jays in assists with five, and she scored six points. **Roberts** added seven points. **Kara Terhune** scored six points, pulled down six rebounds, and had four assists in 19 minutes from off the bench against Susquehanna. Susquehanna turned the ball over 29 times, while Etown had 22 turnovers...

ABOUT DICKINSON

Dickinson is now off to its best start since the 1994-95 season, having improved to 3-1 overall with a 67-38 win at home over Philadelphia Biblical Tuesday night. The Dickinson defense held Philadelphia Biblical to just 23.6% (13-for-55) shooting from the field for the game, and 17.2% (five-for-29) in the second half. Dickinson also held a 53-29 edge in rebounding, and the Red Devils shot 48.3% (29-for-60) from the field and 55.6% (five-for-nine) from three point range for the game. Dickinson also blocked five Philadelphia Biblical shots in the game, although Philadelphia Biblical had fewer turnovers, with 13 as compared to 17 Red Devil turnovers. Philadelphia also had eight steals against six for Dickinson. Dickinson's top scorer Tuesday was **Megan Shelley**, who scored 19 points, shot eight-for-14 from the field and three-for-four from three point range. **Patrice Johnson** scored 10 points. The Red Devils' top rebounder was **Julie Younes** with ten, and she added nine points as well. **Jess Howard** came off the bench and pulled down nine rebounds, and she also tied for the team lead in assists with **Christine Giordano**. Both of them had six assists. **Piper Eteess** scored nine points for Dickinson and pulled down five rebounds, and **Allyson Teatom** scored eight points and had six rebounds from off the bench...
