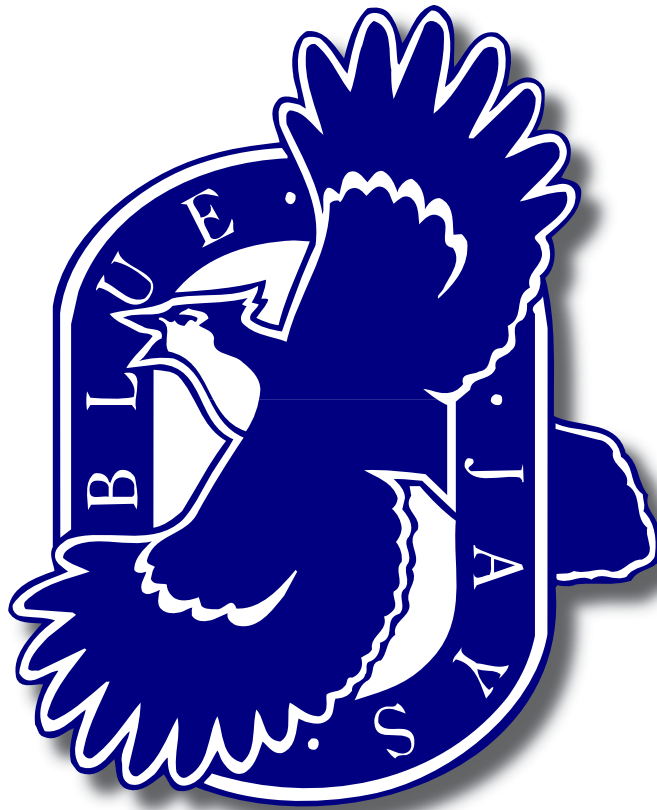

Elizabethtown vs. Immaculata Game Notes...

About Elizabethtown...

Elizabethtown is off to its first 2-0 start since 1999, having won the Rowan University Holiday Inn Tip-Off Tournament title Friday and Saturday. The Blue Jays defeated Neumann College 74-49 Friday and downed Rowan 73-67 Saturday. The wins boosted Elizabethtown's all-time victory total to 895 as the Blue Jays continue to close in on becoming the first NCAA Division III women's basketball program ever to amass 900 victories. **Erin Walton** was named the Commonwealth Conference Player of the Week for last week; it was the second time in her career she has received the honor. At the Rowan Tournament, she averaged 25.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game, and she scored 33 points in the championship game against Rowan. **Megan Quinn** averaged 14.0 points per game from off the bench and shot 52.4% (11-for-21) from the field. She scored 15 points against Neumann and 13 points against Rowan. **Megan Romano** scored 12 points against Neumann in her first game as a Blue Jay and averaged 10.0 points per game for the weekend. Against Neumann, **Jenn Montague** had a double-double as she scored 12 points and grabbed 11 rebounds. **Audrey Hitz** had 12 rebounds and eight points against Neumann, and she had five assists and seven

rebounds against Rowan. **Hitz** averaged 9.5 rebounds per game for the weekend, while **Montague** averaged 8.5 rebounds per game. Elizabethtown is 9-4 all-time against Immaculata. In these teams' most recent meeting, Elizabethtown narrowly came away with a 57-55 road win December 1, 2005 as **Walton** scored 30 points for the first time in her collegiate career. Etown first played Immaculata in 1950-51, with Immaculata winning 41-11.

About Immaculata...

Immaculata opened its 2006-07 season at the Jim Crawley/Frostburg State University Tournament Friday and Saturday. The Mighty Macs lost their opener 74-66 to Frostburg State Friday and bounced back to win the consolation game 78-66 over Grove City College Saturday. Against Frostburg State, **Meg Legere** had a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds, and **Dominique Murray** led the Mighty Macs in scoring with 18 points. **Jessica Dantzler-Henry** totaled 14 points, six rebounds, three assists and five steals against Frostburg State, and **Mary Kate Pawlowski** totaled 13 points, nine rebounds and seven assists. Against Grove City, **Murray** scored 22 points, a career high, and she led the team in rebounds as well with nine. **Dantzler-Henry** scored 18 points, another career-best, and she had eight rebounds, three assists and three

steals. **Pawlowski** tallied 15 points, and **Legere** scored 14 points. Last year, Immaculata went 17-9 overall and finished second in the Pennsylvania Athletic Conference North Division with an 11-5 record.
