Season Summary:

Credit for the 11-3 record, losses only to 3 physical education schools must go to a great team effort as the statistics prove. However, the fantastic outside field goal shooting of Susie Kershner inspired and led her team on many occasions. Senior co-captains and 4 year roommates Susie Kershner and Louise Gaul must take much of the credit for the team's unusual success.

Season Highlights

- 1) It rained through the roof during the Messiah College game. Rags and buckets kept us from getting flooded out of the Messiah gym.
- 2) Shippensburg -- will we ever forget it? No one who was there will !! Before an almost filled gym at Shippensburg we handed a team who had not lost more than 2 games in 3 years what turned out to be their only loss of the 67-68 season. With 3 seconds left, Shippensburg ahead by one and freezing the ball, a little outside rover shot, missed a long one. She and Pat Moyer collided; a double foul was called -- Pat made her 2 shots, Lippy missed hers. With 3 seconds left on the clock; we got the center tap and scored again!! (39-36)

- 4) Gettysburg -- it was our year to win this one too!
