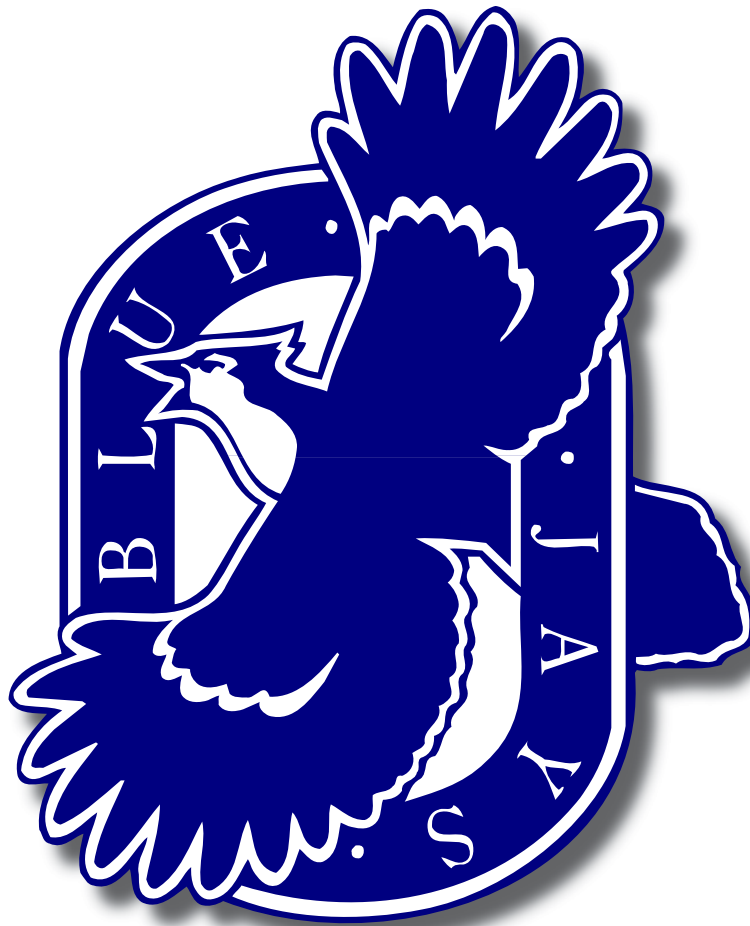

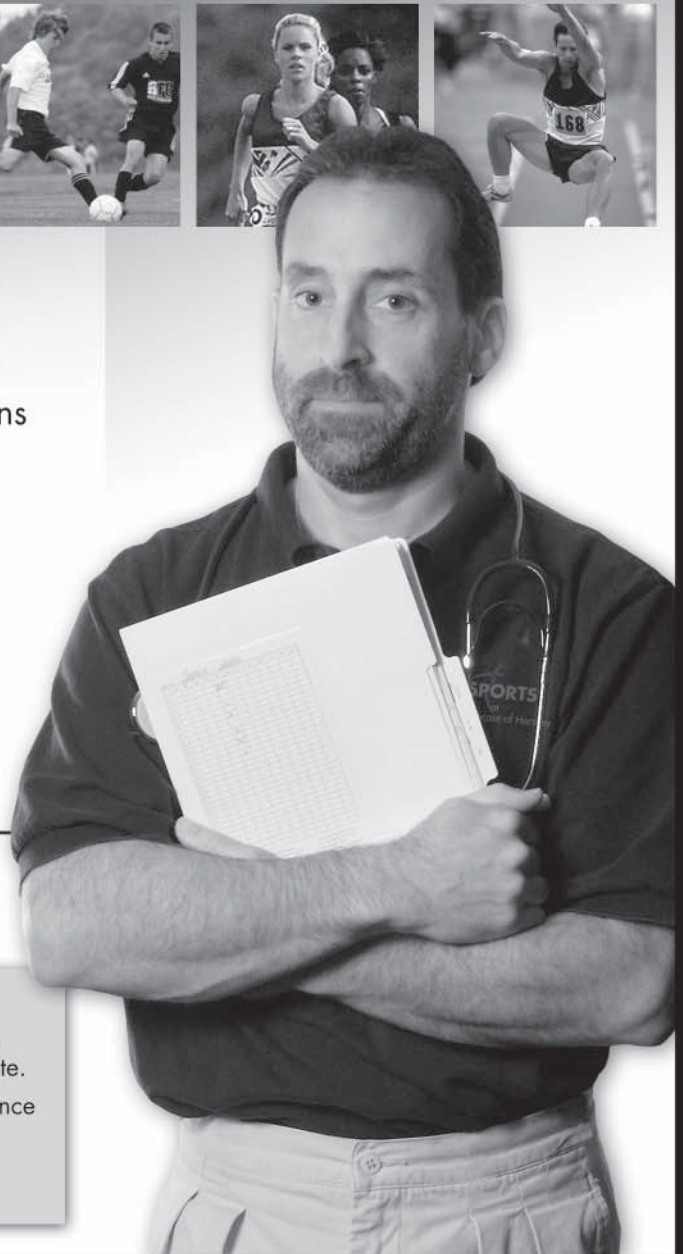

Elizabethtown vs. Virginia Wesleyan Game Notes...

About Elizabethtown...

Elizabethtown opens its 2007 season today. The Blue Jays have never faced Virginia Wesleyan before. Wolf Field has been a good place for the Blue Jays to be recently, as the team went 4-3 at home and 2-8 on the road last year. Elizabethtown has nine first-year students, seven sophomores, three juniors and just one senior on a roster of 20. Despite the team's obvious youth, it is surprisingly experienced for a team so young, as the 2006 roster of 18 players had 10 first-year students and three sophomores. Elizabethtown returns 11 letterwinners from last year's team, and all of them were significant contributors on the 2006 squad that led Elizabethtown to the playoffs for the first time in the history of the program. The Blue Jays also return one 2006 All-Middle Atlantic Conference Second Team selection, sophomore attacker **Katie Foley**, who led Elizabethtown in scoring with 40 goals and in ground balls with 40 last year. The 40 goals were the second-highest total by a first-year student in the history of the program, as well as the fourth-highest total ever at Elizabethtown. She also leads

the returning Blue Jays in draw controls with 26. Last year's team leader in caused turnovers was junior defender **Amanda Reid**, who had 21 in 2006. The captains of the 2007 Blue Jays are senior defender **Jenna Brown** and sophomore mid-fielder **Anna Ford**.

About Virginia Wesleyan...

Currently on a trip through central Pennsylvania, Virginia Wesleyan actually opened its 2007 season yesterday on the road against nationally seventh-ranked Franklin & Marshall College. However, the results of that game could not meet the deadline for this program's printing. In the 2007 Old Dominion Athletic Conference pre-season coaches' poll, the Marlins were picked second. Last year, Virginia Wesleyan finished 14-4 overall, rattled off a 13-game winning streak, and finished as the ODAC runner-up, falling in the conference championship game to Washington & Lee University, which is currently ranked 11th in the nation in the 2007 IWLCA pre-season national rankings. This year's edition of the Marlins is also very young, with eight returning letterwinners, no seniors and just one junior.
