Elizabethtown vs. Muhlenberg/NYU Match Notes

About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays are back on the mats for the first time since Dec. 8, when the squad defeated Scranton 47-6 in their Metropolitan Intercollegiate Wrestling Association opener. In that match, Elizabethtown picked up wins in nine of the 10 bouts, including six pins... Junior **Jereme Heisey** continues to lead the team with 12 wins this season, while sophomores **Eric Rhoads** and **Bud Croswell** each have 11 victories... The Blue Jays have 19 wins at heavyweight this season, led by nine victories from sophomore **Tim Katzaman** while sophomore **Mike Daub** has seven wins and sophomore **Deron Sharp** has added three... At 133 pounds this year, the Jays have compiled an 18-7 record. Rhoads has an 11-3 mark while first-year student **Jarrold Cawley** has contributed seven wins against four defeats... Last season, the Jays defeated host Muhlenberg 37-7 and suffered a 20-15 loss to New York University. Heisey, Sharp and Daub each earned two wins for Etown, with Heisey taking victories at both 157 and 165 pounds.

About Muhlenberg...

Today marks the first dual-meet action of the season for the Mules, who took fifth at the Williams Invitational on Saturday. Junior **Rob Kein** was named Most Outstanding Wrestler after going 4-0 to win at 149 pounds, while junior **Billy Hall** (141 pounds) and senior **Joe Tartar** (285 pounds) also claimed individual titles... Muhlenberg earlier claimed a sixth-place finish at Messiah's Petrofes Invitational, with Hall finishing second at 141 pounds, junior **Justin Fitch** taking third at 174 pounds and first-year student **Bill Sholly** fourth at 197 pounds.

About NYU...

The Violets won their fourth straight dual match last Saturday with a 29-9 win over Centenary. NYU picked up wins in eight of the 10 bouts, including a fall by first-year student **Matt Magill** in 2:30 at 149 pounds... Two NYU wrestlers are nationally ranked in the latest poll, as senior **Nick Coleman** is seventh at 184 pounds and senior **Steve Hult** is ninth at 141 pounds. Hult is 15-4 on the season with four falls and two third-place tournament finishes, while Coleman is 16-3 with three falls and a championship at the Red Dragon Invitational.
